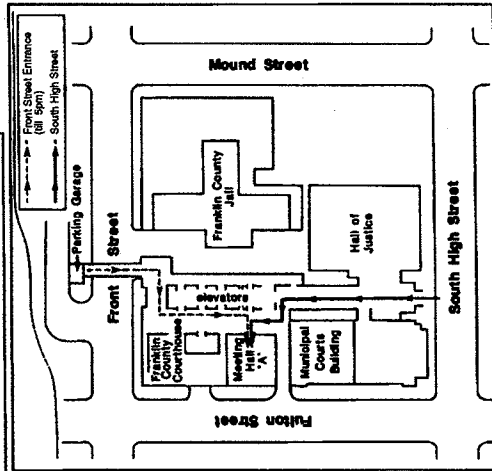
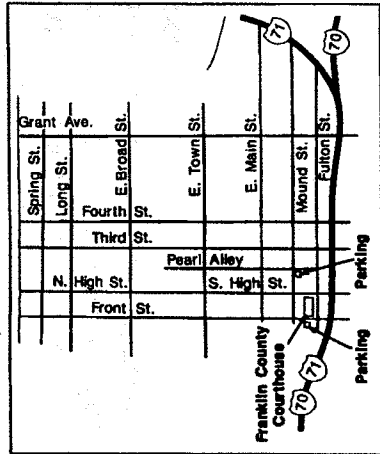

Parking garages are located at:

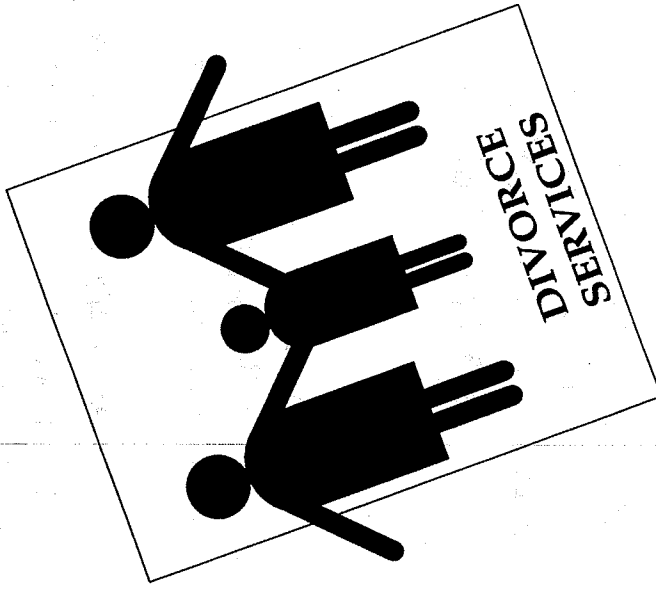
- 399 South Front Street

Parents are Forever

Divorce is a very stressful experience for parents and children. Although spouses may decide to end their marriage, their children will always need both their parents to be part of their lives.

This 2 1/2 hour seminar will focus on what children need during and after the divorce and how parents can help them succeed.

Time:

Four seminars will be held each month. Morning, afternoon and evening sessions are available.

Who Must Attend:

By local rule of The Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Division of Domestic Relations, all parents with minor children who are parties to a divorce, dissolution, or legal separation action must attend within 45 days of filing. **Parents are encouraged to attend as early as possible.**

How to Register:

Pre-registration is required. Call the Divorce Services registration line at 355-8325 and you will be asked to give the following information on a recorded message:

- Name as it appears on legal papers.
- Spell your name.
- Divorce Court case number
- Phone number.
- Choice of seminar date and time.
- Whether you would prefer to attend at a different time than your child's other parent.
- Parents whose case is filed in a county other than Franklin must indicate this when registering.
- Each parent must pre-register separately.

At The Seminar:

- Arrive 15 minutes early to sign in and receive materials.
- Bring divorce court case number to seminar.
- Do not bring children to the seminar. Child care is not provided.
- Certificates will be given to parents who complete the entire program. The program will notify the court of your attendance.
